LAUREN MORANDO RHIM, Ph.D. is an independent education consultant specializing in pressing education issues including charter schools, school restructuring and turnaround, special education, state and district support for school improvement, and virtual schools. She is currently working closely with the University of Virginia's School Turnaround Specialist Program to assess and expand its leadership program and has conducted research on school turnaround initiatives in Chicago and Philadelphia. She is co-author of *School Turnarounds: Cross-Sector Evidence on Dramatic Organizational Improvement*, a review of the cross-industry literature related to school turnarounds which was published by the Center on Innovation and Improvement for which she serves on the Scientific Council. Prior to becoming an independent consultant, Dr. Rhim was a Senior Consultant with Public Impact, an education policy and management consulting firm where she conducted her own work and lead project teams to produce research, evaluation, technical assistance and consulting. Prior to joining Public Impact, she was a Faculty Research Associate in the College of Education at the University of Maryland, College Park, where she conducted both research and external consulting and evaluations.
