Angela Denning is the deputy associate superintendent of school improvement and intervention for the Arizona Department of Education (ADE), Division of School Effectiveness. She coordinates support and assistance to schools in improvement status under the state accountability system, AZ LEARNS and NCLB. In addition, Angela oversees the implementation of the Solutions Team process, guides the on-going refinement of the Arizona School Improvement Plan, provides leadership to the ADE School Improvement and Intervention team, and collaborates with staff from other divisions within ADE in an effort to coordinate services to schools. Previously, Angela was the director of K-12 literacy assessments for the K-12 literacy section of the school effectiveness division, a literacy coach and a special education teacher. A veteran educator for 19 years, Angela has a masters degree of curriculum and instruction in language and literacy from Arizona State University.
